


Dog Trivia Questions!

1. Q: What are the names of the Redbone Coonhounds in the novel Where the Red Fern Grows?

3. Q: A dog of this breed was the first recipient of the Best in Show award at Westminster Kennel Club in 1907.
4. Q: The breed name is translated into English as “Monkey-terrier”, so named for its monkey-like face and compact terrier build.
5. Q: Often referred to as a “Presidential” breed since more presidents have owned this type of dog than any other.
6. Q: Known sometimes as the “barkless dog”, referring to its yodeling tendencies.
7. Q: Name one of the three breeds added to the American Kennel Club in 2011.
8. Q: Originally bred as an African hunting dog, this breed is now best distinguished by a ridge of hair growing in the wrong direction along its back.
9. Q: This breed was developed by a German tax collector to protect him during his occasionally dangerous collections.
10. Q: These were bred solely by the state-owned Red Star Kennel as military and working dogs until 1957, when some puppies were sold to civilian breeders.
11. Q: This breed is named after a character who owned several of these dogs in Sir Walter Scott’s 1814 novel Guy Mannering.

12. Q: A breed native to France, several representatives were brought to North America by Thomas Jefferson.
13. Q: This breed was brought to the United States by Helen Keller.
14. Q: Queen Victoria, after bringing an individual over from Italy, dramatically influenced this breed's development and popularity.
15. Q: Name two breeds with genetically fixed double dewclaws.
