Part I:

(22 points)

(while you may use the internet for hour boni (for fewer points), we strongly recommend you do this one without help. if you use the internet, you will not be eligible for bonus points)

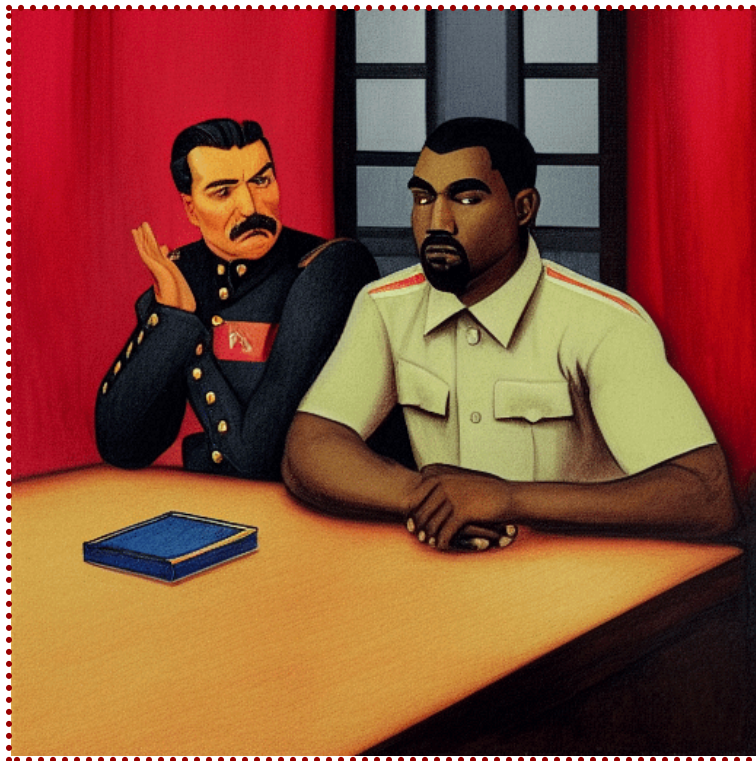
