### Part I : Tanks but no tanks? (48 points; 1 or 2 each)

Journalists and Russian attack helicopter pilots alike are famously bad at identifying what is or is not a tank. Let's see if you can do better.

You'll be identifying whether or not vehicles are (or were) **Main Battle Tanks (MBTs)**, which Wikipedia helpfully defines as "a tank that fills the role of armor-protected direct fire and maneuver in many modern armies."

Of course, that's not to be confused with armored cars, assault guns, light tanks, heavy tanks, anti-aircraft tanks, Armored Personnel Carriers (APCs), Infantry Fighting Vehicles (IFVs), the umbrella term Armored Fighting Vehicles (AFVs), Mine-Resistant Ambush Protected vehicles (MRAPs), Self-Propelled Guns (SPGs), and the rest of the military acronym salad.

There are 30 images, 12 of which are tanks.

If a vehicle is not a tank, you can get a second point for identifying what kind of vehicle it is (e.g. plane, infantry fighting vehicle, self-propelled gun, light tank). Err on the side of precision, but you don't need to tell us the exact model of vehicle.

You know what's more **manly** than Rome? Rome but **WAR**.

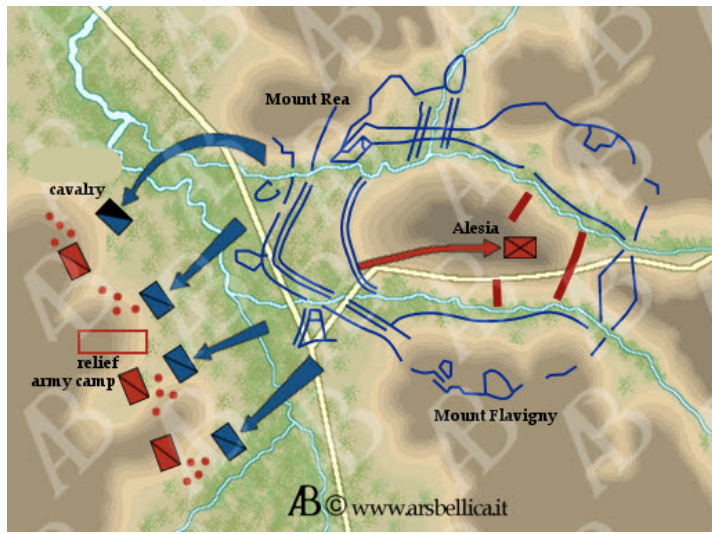
Rome fought 10 of these battles, winning half and losing half. Which did it win? Which did it lose?

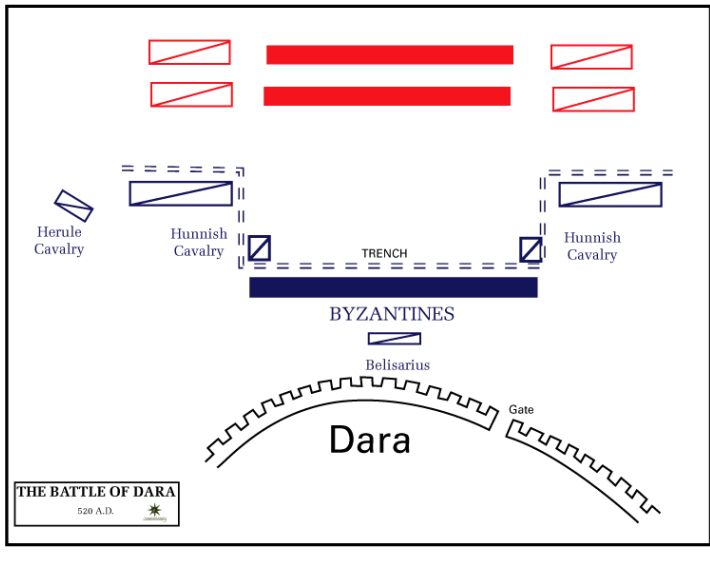
Battle of the Catalaunian Plains, 451
