3. **P2D2**—Name an English word that fits into the pattern P??D??, where a ? can be any letter. Each of the ?s can be different letters. This word must be in Merriam-Webster, and must not be archaic, obsolete, or only found in the Unabridged version. Proper nouns and hyphenated words are also not allowed.
4. **US vs. Good Time in Vegas**—Name a poker variant included in the World Series of Poker.
5. **Beautiful Human Submarines**—Name a Democrat who participated in one of the primary debates in the 2020 election.

12. **Requiem for the Blue Civic**—Name an instrument that is part of a symphony orchestra, excluding percussion.
13. **Noumenal Yodeling**—Name a child in the fictional Von Trapp family.
14. **Must Capture Moose and Squirrel**—Name one of the seven living vertebrate classes in phylum Chordata. Your answer must use the Latin name for the class, but we will overlook spelling errors.
15. **BOMO**—Name an English word that fits into the pattern ?O?O, where a ? can be any letter. Each of the ?s can be different letters. This word must be in Merriam-Webster, and must not be archaic, obsolete, or only found in the Unabridged version. Proper nouns and hyphenated words are also not allowed.
16. **Second Place Stars**—Name a single word SI Unit other than second.
17. **The Ohio Players**—Name a member of the Big Ten Conference other than Ohio State University.
18. **Return of the Large Hadron Collider: Harder Better Faster Stronger**—Name a word in the song "Harder Better Faster Stronger" other than the words in the title.

23. **I’m Oxford (dot com) and Friends**—Name a non-alphanumeric symbol found on a standard American English keyboard.
24. **The Ubernebulous Space Otters of Alpha Centauri**—Name an animal represented in the Chinese Zodiac.
25. **Lay Men: JC Superstars: Take Me, Caiaphas**—Name one of Jesus’ apostles.
