This one is for all of you literature lovers. Below is a set of synopses for fake books. Name the book, and as usual, name the source. The source may be a movie, book, videogame, television show, or even webcomic.

90. Written by Chthon, it collects knowledge of magic. The book itself has magical powers that had to be contained by Merlin and St. Brendan. Pages do occasional service and turn people into worms, or teach androids how to make dimensional portals
91. A very long book about a farm boy who falls in love with the most beautiful girl. Includes long sections about wedding traditions, Fencing, fighting, torture, revenge, giants, monsters, chases, escapes, true love, miracles, and no reunion scene. Readers are invited to write Harourt Brace Jovanovich to get an approximation of what the reunion scene would be.

Temperance Barrows of Nantucket, her two offspring, and her husband Captain Mordecai Barrows experience hardship after the drunken, rude Mordecai Barrows returns unsuccessfully from a whaling trip. When Captain Mordecai finds out that Temperance is pregnant by Cyrus, Mordecai impales Cyrus against a whale that Temperance had admired, but the rope from the harpoon pulls Mordecai under with Cyrus and the whale.
93. Published by Megadodo Publications, this book serves as your personal guide to anything you might encounter while making your way, well, anywhere.
94. A long tale about a short creature, thirteen of his newest friends, and their there-again-gone-again friend who can actually reach things.
95. Goldstein's Book; illegal, amateurishly bound, and required reading for the brotherhood.
