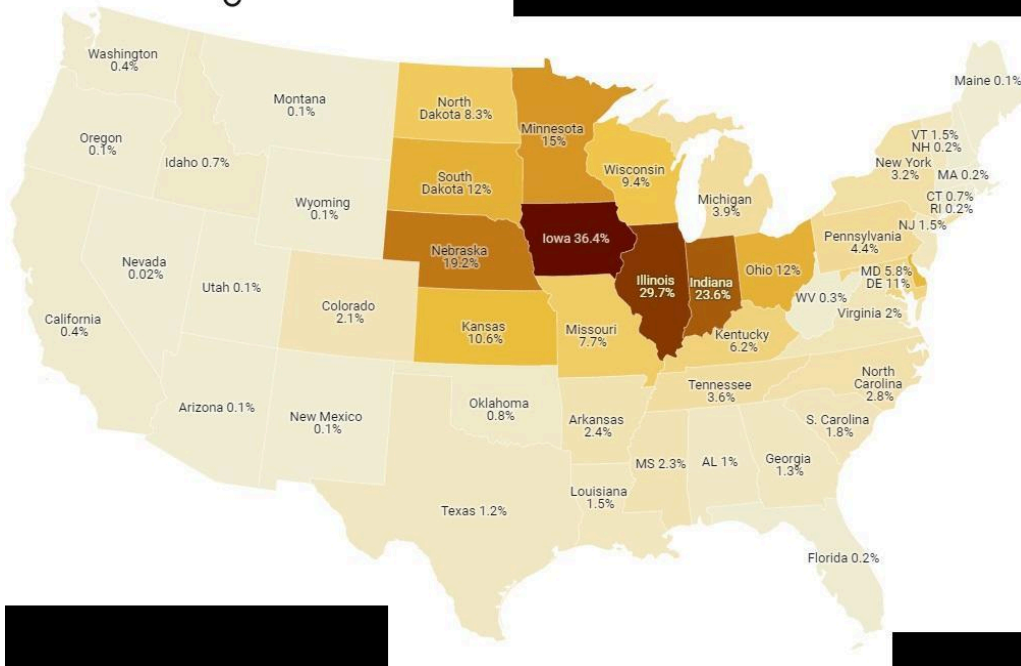

Part 1: THE UNITED STATES

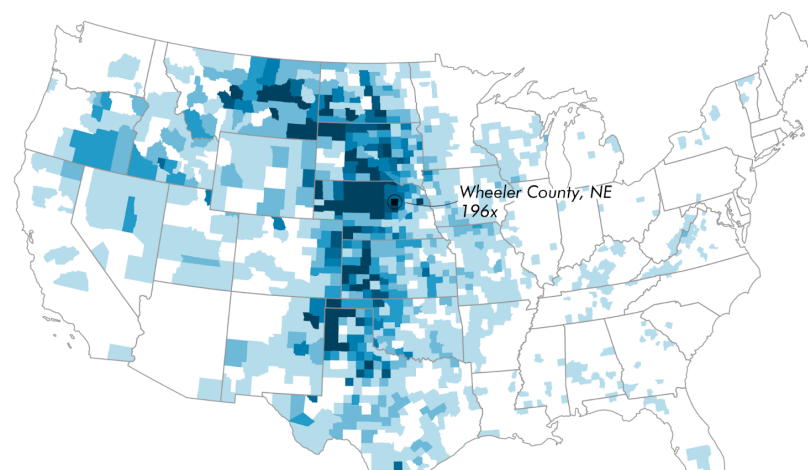
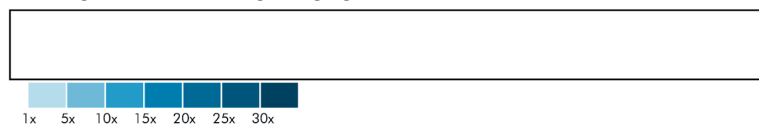
The country best known as the home of Too Many Noodles!

1. Iowa: The state with the highest...something! This map's creator said that Alaska and Hawaii were "negligible" - kind of rude, frankly

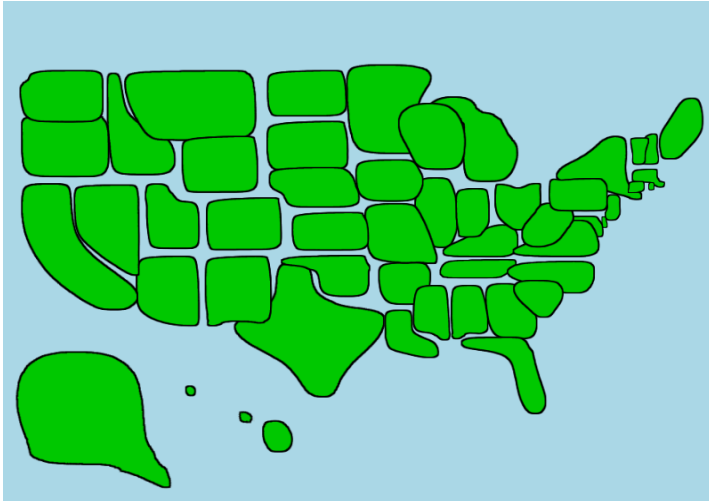
Percentage of Each State



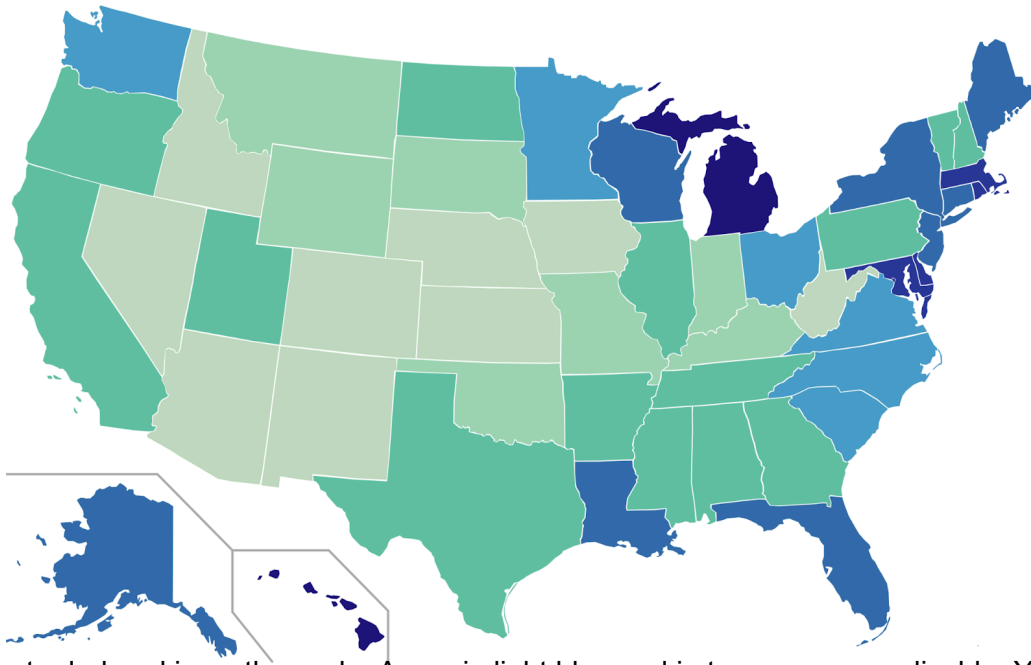
2. And Wheeler County, Nebraska, is the national leader in something else! Alaska and Hawaii got excluded again for having negligible values



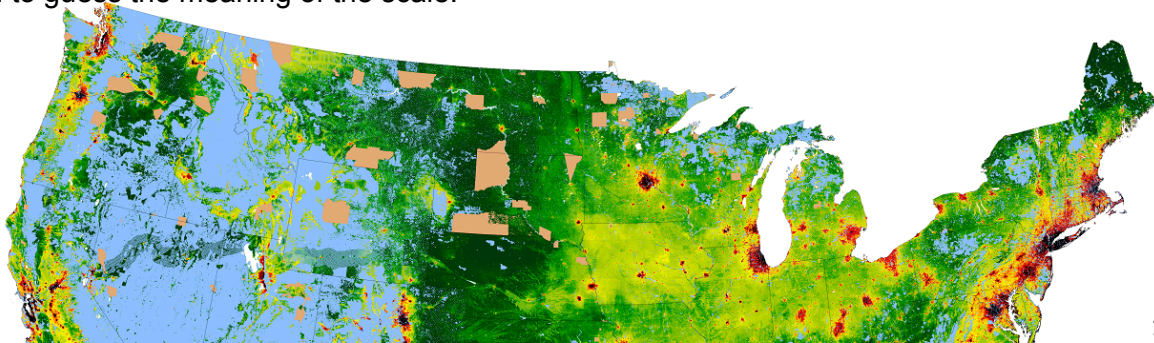
3. How was this map created? Not very well, clearly



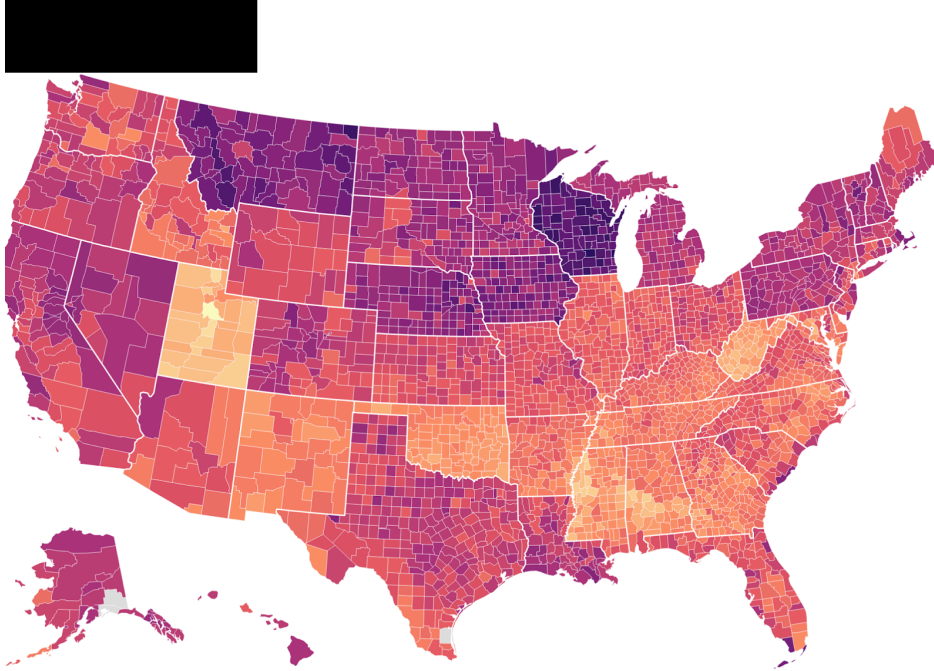
4. On a scale from light green to dark blue, how the heck are we comparing these states?



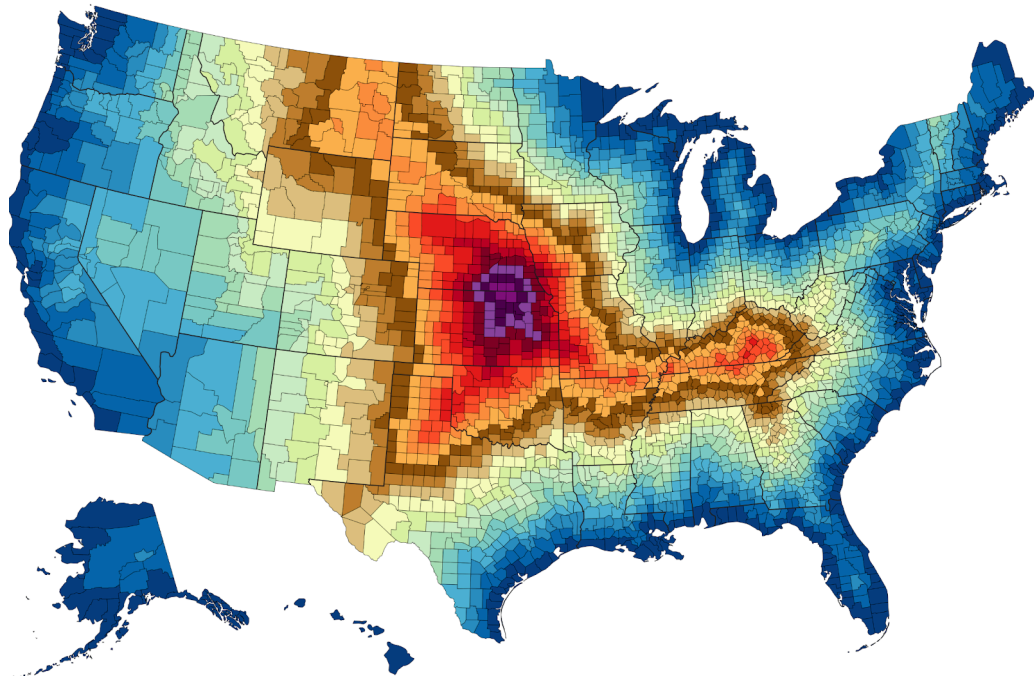
5. Green to dark red is on the scale. Areas in light blue and in tan are non-applicable. You only need to guess the meaning of the scale.



6. US counties by...how much they like purple? No? Do you have a better idea?

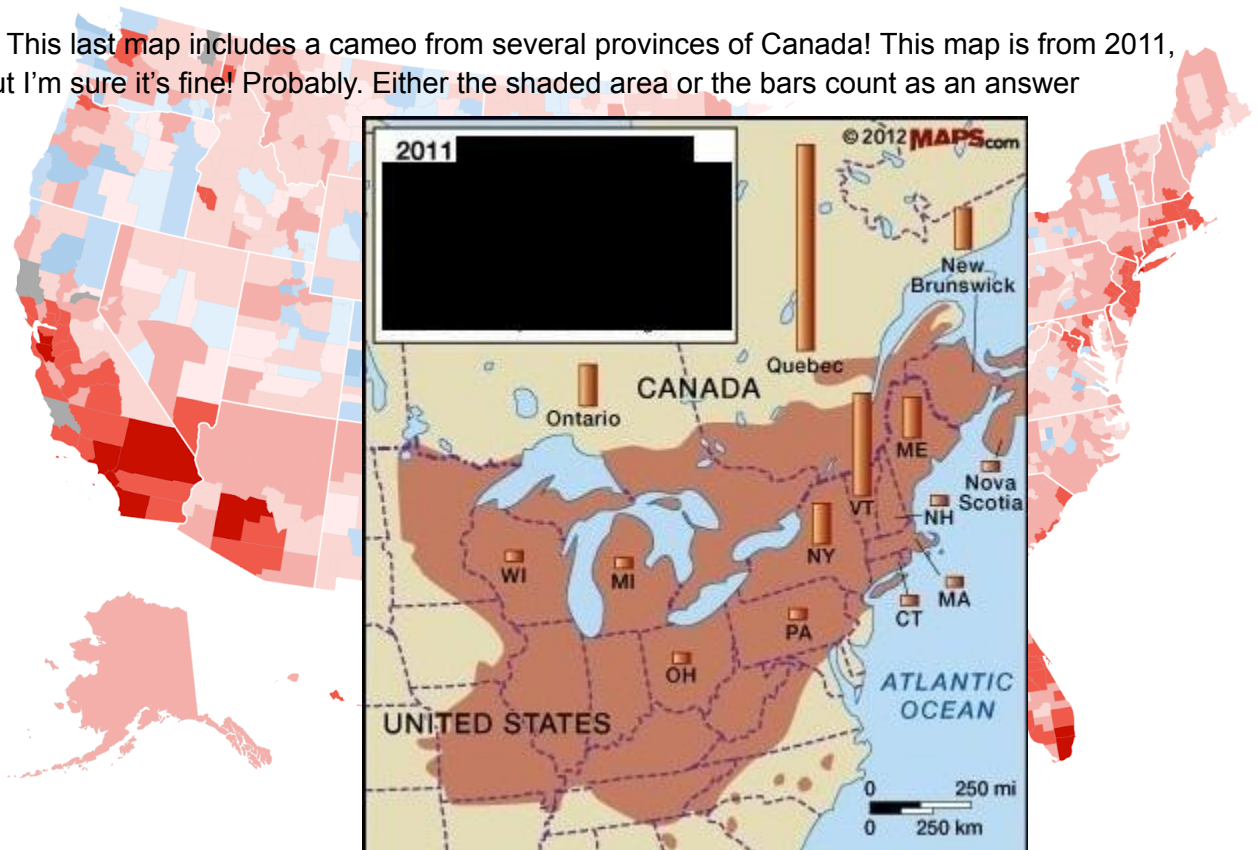


7. Ha! This map has an AMOGUS! But apparently the colors represent something else, too

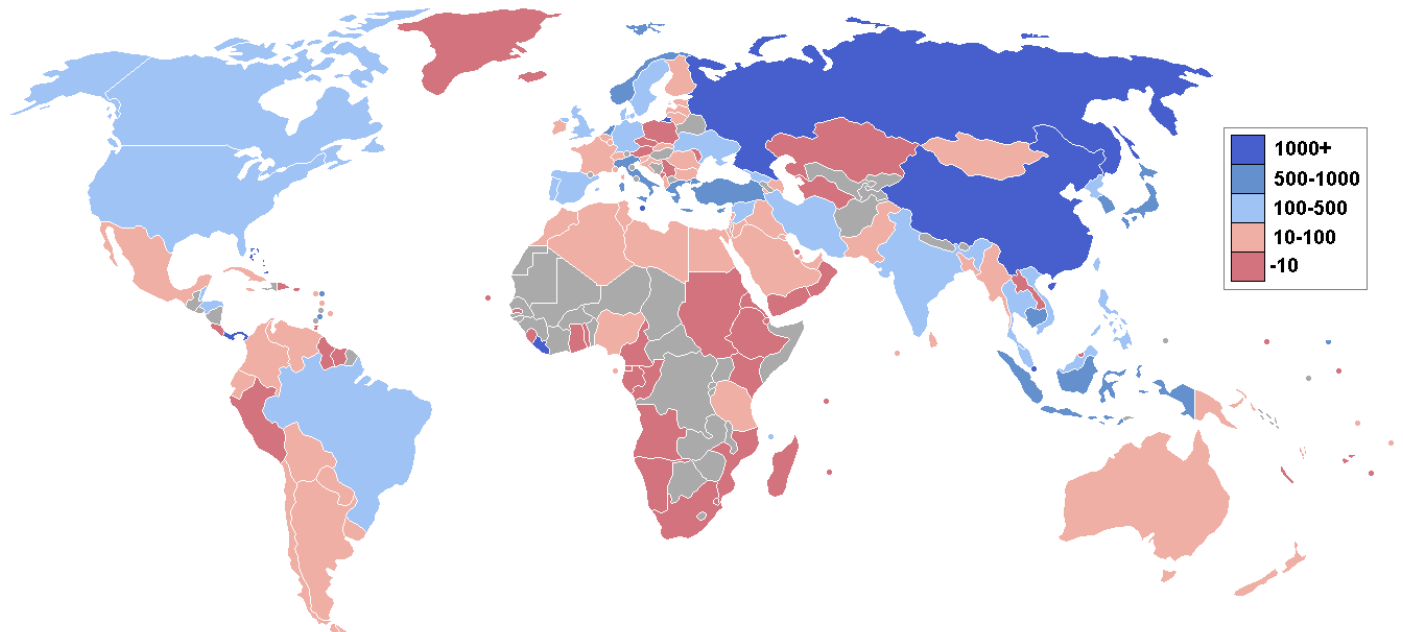


Part 2: THE WORLD

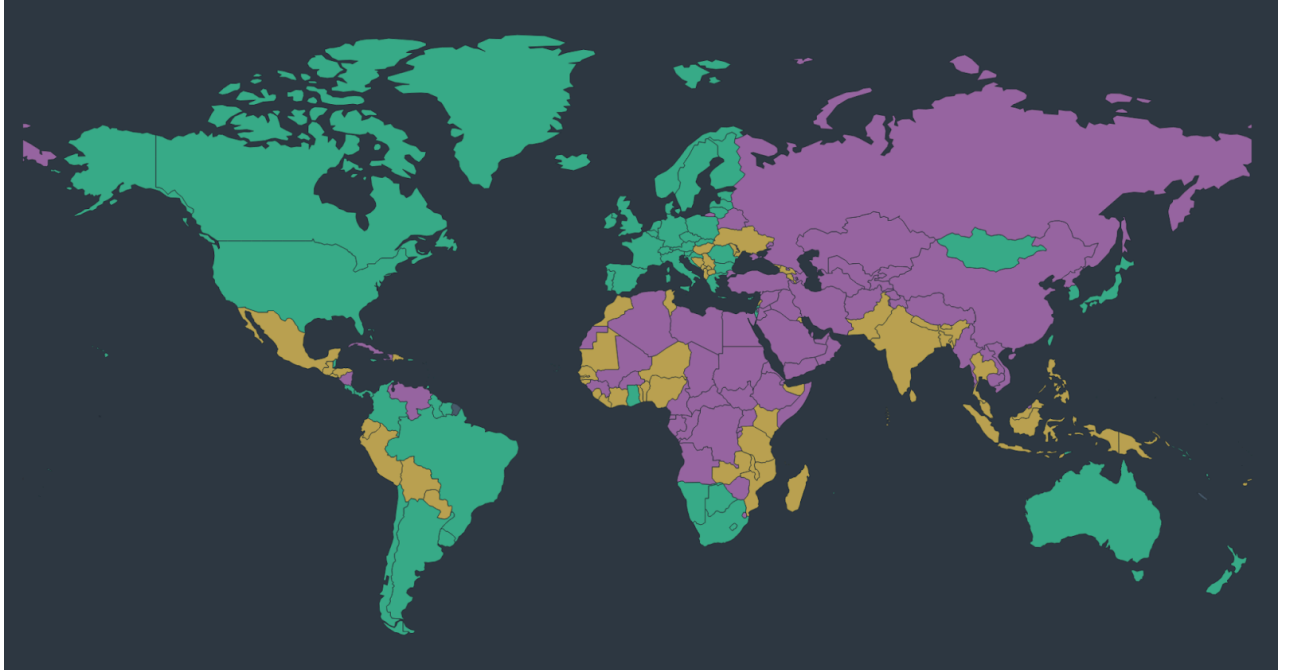
One of the Top 5 planets

All maps are up-to-date within the last 5 years. We think.

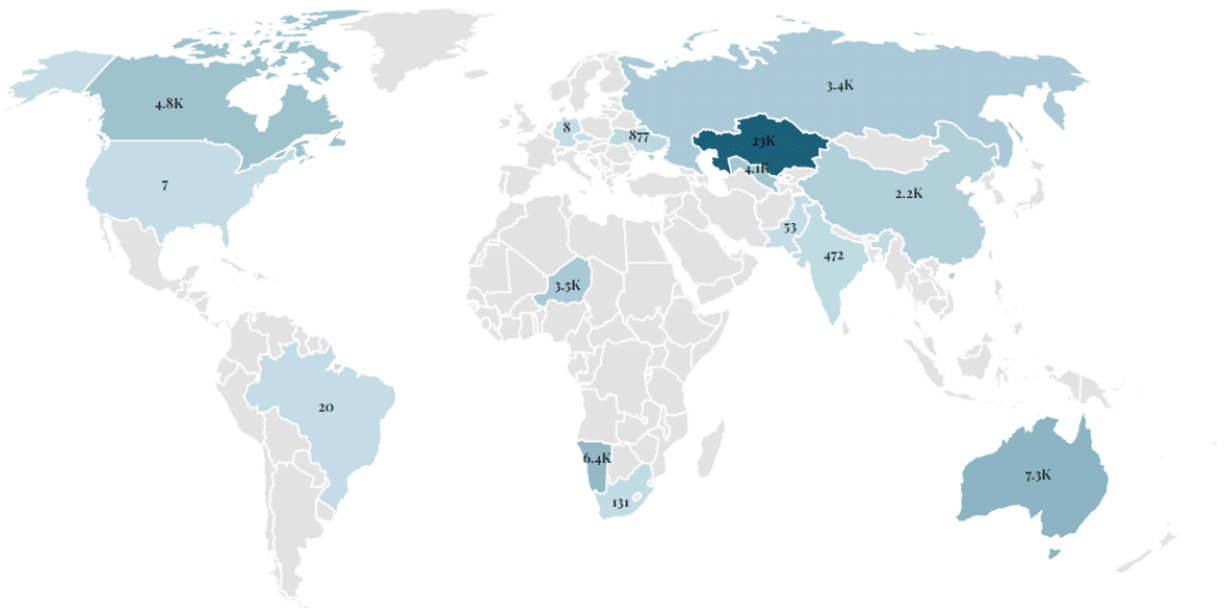
10.) Grey = either zero or no data



11.) Some countries are purple, too!



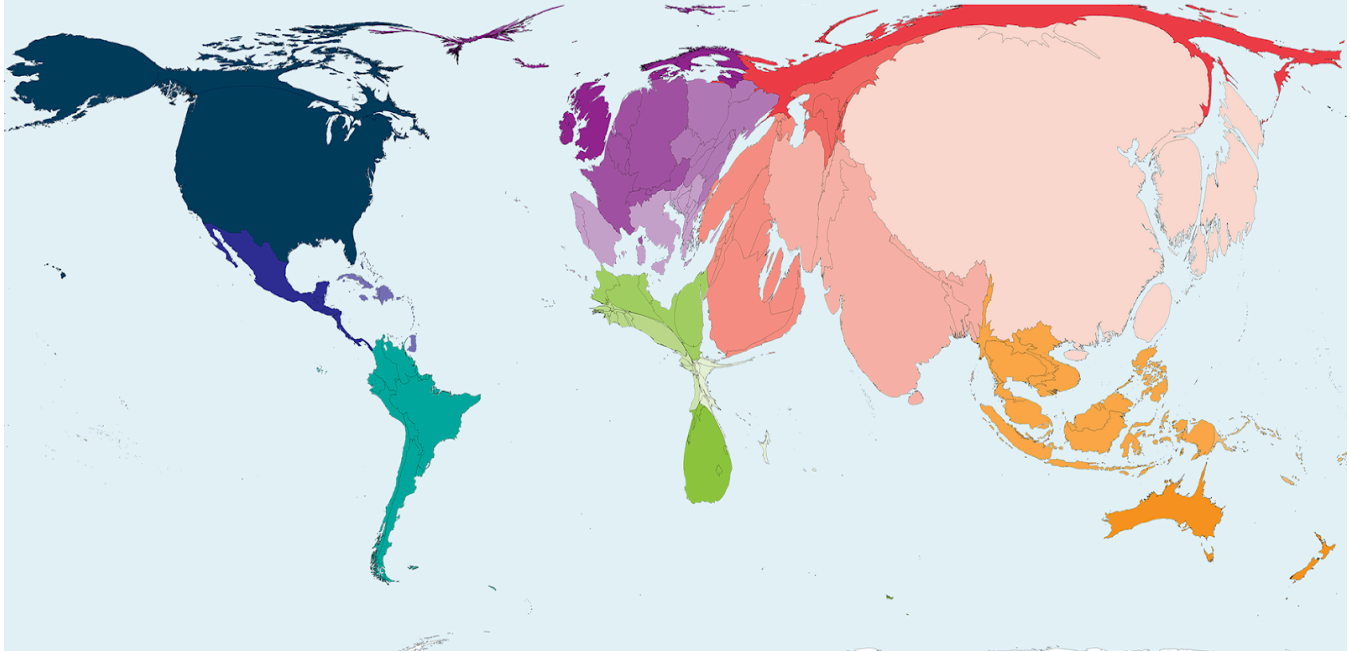
12.) Blank = either zero or no data for that country



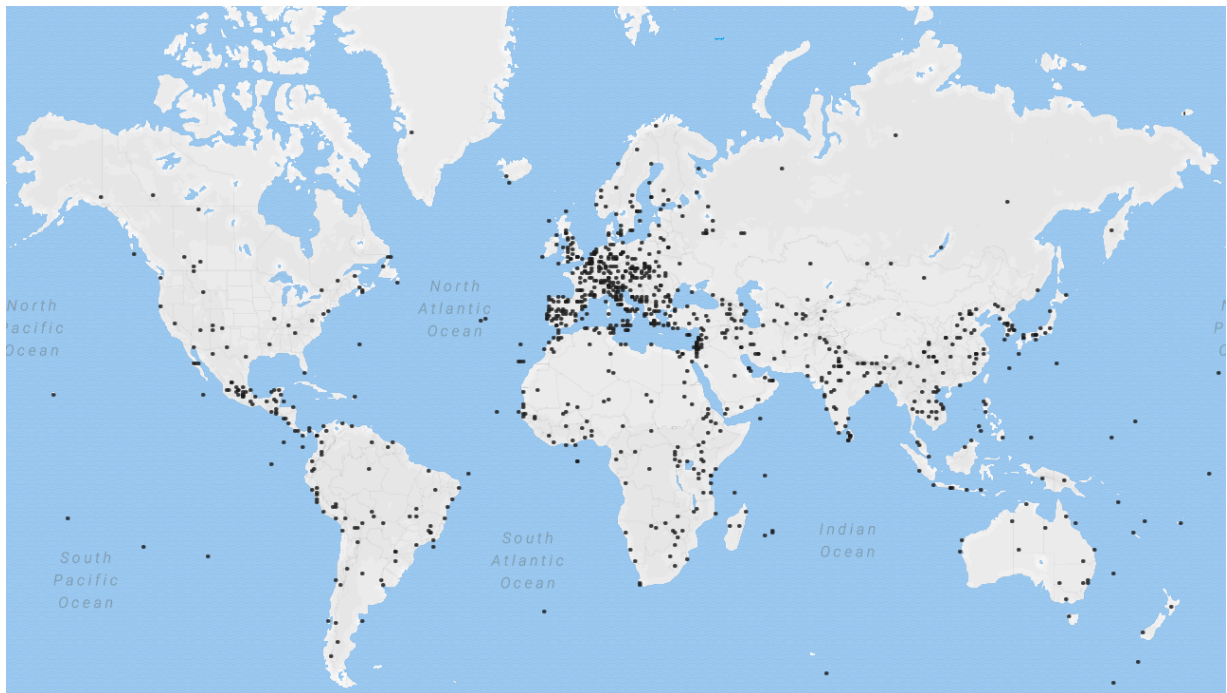
13.) Sudan and South Sudan have disappeared! Or maybe we just don't have data for them



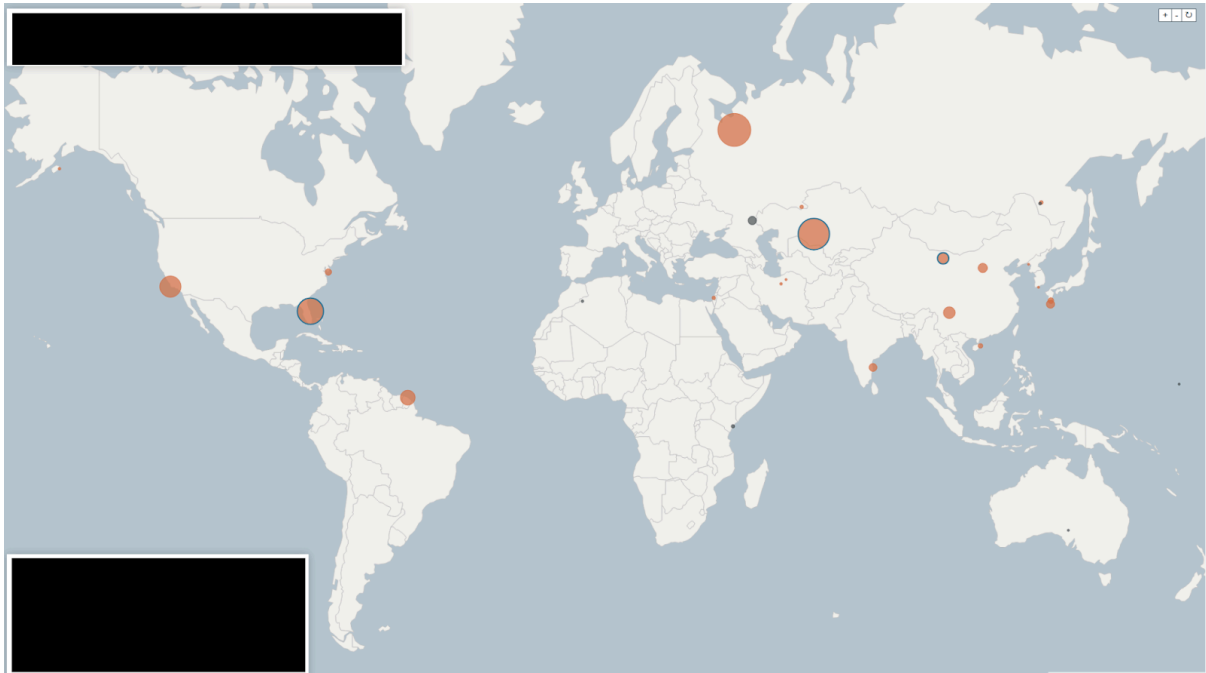
14.) Something went horribly wrong in the making of this map! Wait, that's actually a design choice? Why the hell would you resize the countries like that?



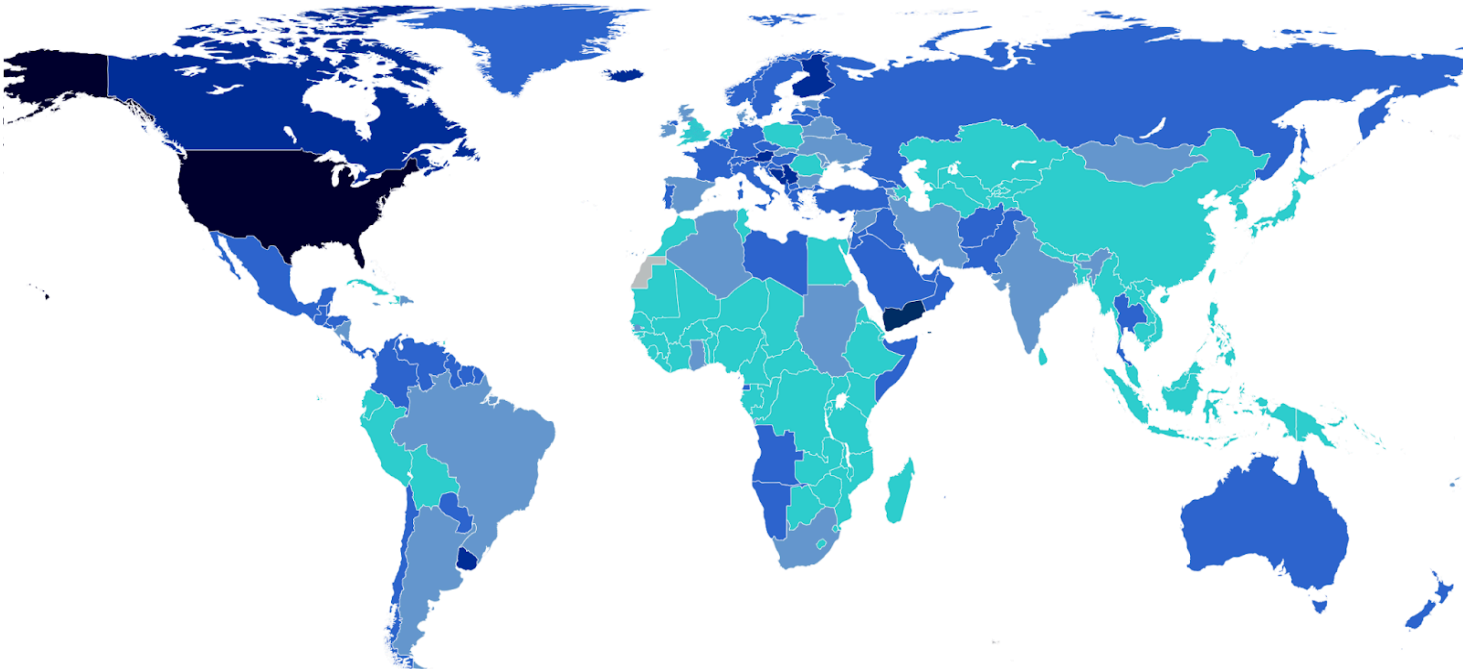
15.) They forgot to add color to this map. Just a whole bunch of little dots that each represent one...something.
