2. This Kennedy entered the Senate in 1962, making him the fourth-longest serving U.S. senator in American history. Educated at Harvard and UVA, name this youngest brother of JFK.
Edward Kennedy
3. This Kennedy is often considered the architect of the political dynasty. Sometimes incorrectly accused of making his vast fortune from bootlegging, name this ambassador to United Kingdom disgraced for his support of appeasement policies toward Germany and father of President John F. Kennedy.
Joseph P. Kennedy, Sr.
4. It is sometimes said that her sister founded the Special Olympics in response to the lobotomy which she underwent at the age of 23. Name this eldest daughter of Joe Kennedy, Sr. and Rose Fitzgerald Elizabeth Kennedy.
Rosemary Kennedy
5. This Kennedy was assassinated by Sirhan Sirhan in 1968 while on the campaign trail for the Democratic nomination for President. Name this Kennedy famous for a speech he gave after the assassination of MLK in which he quoted the Greek playwright Aeschylus.
Robert F. Kennedy
6. This Kennedy, educated at Brown and Boston College, was previously married to the current governor of New York.
