| 10 | The Queen can move like any other piece on the board, except for the knight |

| 12 | The goal is to collect three cards of the same design, one of each of the three designs, or two cards of the same design plus a wild card to trade them in later |
| 13 | When a player lands on a licorice spot, the player's piece is frozen for one turn |
| 14 | If a player lands on an unowned property, he or she can buy it for the listed price on the board |
| 15 | Players must fire shots on their enemies by calling out space numbers |
| 16 | The spy is the only piece that can capture a marshal as long as the spy attacks first |
