Hour One

Sympathy for the Devil → logo for the New Jersey Devils professional hockey team

Start Me Up → car starter

Under My Thumb → thumbs-up hand sign

Hour Two

Happy → promotional material for children's movie *Happy Feet*

Get Off of My Cloud → logo for Apple's iCloud

Wild Horses → stampede of wild horses

Hour Three

Street Fighting Man → famous photograph from May 1968 protests in France, which served as an inspiration for the song

Paint It Black → Kazimir Malevich's *Black Square*, a 1915 painting from Russian suprematism and represented a turning point for abstraction in art history

Honky Tonk Women → Jerry Lee Lewis and Honky Tonk Cafe in downtown Memphis, which is specified as the setting of the song in the opening line

Hour Four

Angie → promotional material for TBS comedy crime television show *Angie Tribeca*

Jumpin' Jack Flash → GQ photoshoot of Jackie Chan from the 1990s

Play With Fire → fire-breather from a circus performance

Hour Five

She's So Cold → promotional material of Elsa from the Disney movie *Frozen*

Gimme Shelter → images of Soviet missiles in Cuba captured by American spy planes during the Cuban Missile Crisis, which served as an inspiration for the apocalyptic lyrics of the song

You Can't Always Get What You Want → photo of the iconic Chelsea Drugstore in west London that served as a symbol of modernity and the setting of the third verse of the song

Hour Six

Mother's Little Helper → stock image of the yellow pills mentioned in the first verse of the song

Tumbling Dice → stock photo of rolling dice

As Tears Go By → photo from Michael Jordan's speech at his induction to the Basketball Hall of Fame and source of the popular Crying Jordan Internet meme

Hour Seven

It's Only Rock 'N Roll (But I Like It) → Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in downtown Cleveland

Beast and Burden → promotional material from the recent live-action remake of Disney's *Beauty and the Beast* with Emma Watson

Ruby Tuesday → promotional material from the American restaurant Ruby Tuesday's

Hour Eight

Satisfaction → satisfaction guarantee badge commonly seen on the packaging of goods

Brown Sugar → Domino's light brown sugar

Midnight Rambler → Philadelphia 76ers basketball player Andrew Toney, nicknamed the Boston Strangler for his stellar performances against the Boston Celtics in the 1980s. The song is a biography of the 1960s serial killer Albert DeSalvo, otherwise known as the Boston Strangler
