## Historical Facts

- Near Bonnie and Clyde hide-out in Black Lake, Louisiana, FBI men ambush bank robbers
- 1st election in Washington Territory with 1,682 votes cast, and for the 1st time coal gas is used to light major streets in San Francisco.
- The US Bureau of Indian Affairs established and J W Goodrich introduced rubber galoshes to the public.

- Ulysses S. Grant is named commander of the Union armies during the Civil War
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr receives the Nobel Peace Prize.
- Massachusetts Governor Elbridge Gerry signs a redistricting bill - first "gerrymander" and (Eastern) Louisiana admitted as 18th US state. Also, the US declares war against Britain.
- Stephen King, a 26-year-old author, published his debut novel "Carrie,"
- Franklin D. Roosevelt becomes the only U.S. president to be elected to a fourth term and the average Cost of a new house is \$3,450.00.
- 1st airplane flight from LA to SF and the 1st international figure-skating tournament held in the US, New Haven.
- The Soviet Nuclear reactor at Chernobyl exploded on April 26th causing release of radioactive material across much of Europe.
- Pope Pius X banned low cut dresses in the presence of churchmen and the US began construction on the Panama Canal.
