A **ship**, short for a relation*ship*, is a pairing of fictional characters from books, movies, TV, etc., or real people, as desired by fans. These pairings may or may not become "canon," that is, canonical or real, in the original media itself or in real life. They also may be incestuous or otherwise illegal and inappropriate. Still, that won't stop the fanfiction writers or fan artists. A ship is also a watercraft.

The answers to this round take the form of the names of the people in the "ship" in question, though the nautical-themed suggestions will serve as helpful hints to one of their names or identities, or their context.

Example: Canon pair from iconic trio; shared first year boat ride to school together Answer: Ron/Hermione

- 6. Interspecies DreamWorks couple; offspring can swim, walk, or fly
- 7. Real couple, onscreen heroes; no wave home
- 8. President and First Lady; South Pacific naval hero
- 9. (Not fused) lesbian gems; from Ocean City
- 10. Slayer and her nemesis; boat securing object
- 11. 90's TV spooky pair; competitive rowing
- 12. 2010's TV gay spooky pair; holy vessel
- 13. Nordic brothers; spaceship occupants
- 14. Victorian "roommates"; canal mechanism
- 15. Cuban-American Republican senators; luxury vacation
