

Part 1: "The most dramatic episode yet!" Name the reality TV show given an overly dramatic incident from the show:

- 13. Which contestant was the only member remaining on their tribe before the merge in *Survivor: Palau?*

Part 3: "They made *THAT* a **TV show?"** Name the reality TV show given a description taken from Wikipedia:

- 15. Contestants enter a magical chamber which "transforms" them into pop singers, whom they impersonate while performing the singers' hit songs.
- 16. In the show, the children try to create a functioning society in the town, including setting up a government system with minimal adult help and supervision.
- 17. The series follows twelve American women who are led to believe that they are competing for the affections of Prince Harry. However, in reality the bachelor is Matthew Hicks, a Prince Harry look-alike.
- 18. Based on the Dutch series of the same name, it had celebrities performing dives from extreme heights and challenges increasing in difficulty each week.
